California Proposition (CP) 65 Declaration of Conformity

Declaration of Conformity to the California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986

Proposition 65 (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) is a California law that requires companies to inform Californians about chemicals that may cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. The law requires that no person engaged in business knowingly and intentionally exposes any person to a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive toxicity without first providing a clear and reasonable warning. By requiring this information to be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposure to these chemicals.

The scope of the law applies exclusively to consumer products (B2C).
Our products are intended for commercial and industrial use (B2B).

Nevertheless, we hereby confirm that our products do not contain any substances of concern according to the current [Prop 65 list](#), or that they will not be made available on the market without explicit labeling if the maximum permissible exposure limits are exceeded.
